

Hampshire White Riders Membership Meeting Minutes

April 3, 2019

Call to order: President Dwain Stadie called the meeting to order at 7:31pm. There were no guests present this evening. Dwain noted this will be a short meeting with a pizza party to follow.

Secretary's report: Secretary Kathy Meindl was unable to attend the meeting tonight. Chris Black recorded the minutes in her absence.

Treasurer's report: Treasurer Rich Jelinek passed out information on the current as well as the proposed budget. He noted that the rent on the storage shed will increase by 150%. The members discussed the proposed budget and it was accepted and approved.
