VILLAGE OF HAMPSHIRE SNOWMOBILING REGULATIONS

The Hampshire White Riders Snowmobile Club has had an agreement with The Village since 1980 about snowmobiling in Hampshire. With the first snow this year there have been several questions about riding in the village. We need to get the word out ourselves to everyone. I think social media, and all of us members talking to anyone in the Village of Hampshire who will listen is key.

The rules and regulations for snowmobiling in the Village of Hampshire are:

1-You can ride any village street STRICKLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF GETTING TO AND FROM THE TRAIL AT A SPEED OF 15mph OR LESS, NO JOY RIDING IN THE VILLAGE.

2-You cannot ride on State Street, you can cross State Street, but you cannot ride on it.

3-You cannot cross State Street between Terwillger and Washington (Downtown Business District) due to the poor visibility

HWR BONFIRE / HOT DOG ROAST

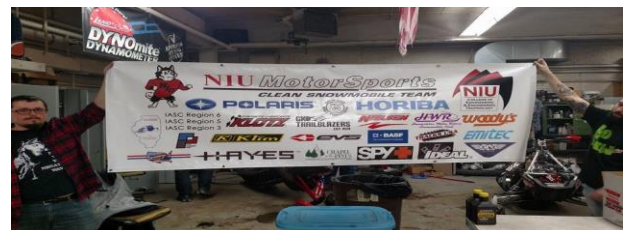
This event kicked-off the 2016-2017 season on October 22nd as members gathered at the Haseman residence while the Cubs playoff game was on. A good time was had by all those attending

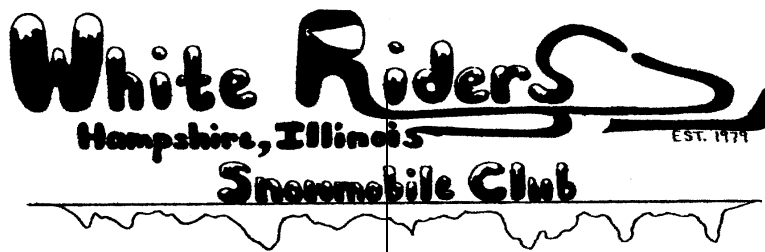
